

Vinlisa Biography

Vinlisa is a Cambodian-American contemporary RnB artist, singer, and songwriter who currently lives and works in New Orleans. After living in various states across the nation, her music background has been drastically influenced and diversified throughout her life.

Vinlisa's desire to create music sprung impulsively when she released her first cover of "Thinkin Bout You" by Frank Ocean on YouTube back in 2015. Previously known as the "quiet girl" in high school, the positive feedback from her peers enabled her to step out of her comfort zone by making YouTube videos, eventually landing herself 23,000 views on her take of the #tentoesdown challenge called "Flex On Your Ex" in 2017. After a series of bedroom covers, Vinlisa decided senior year of high school to pursue her music career by enrolling at Loyola University of New Orleans to study Music Business. She has released three solo singles "Wavelength," "High," and "Take This Slow," which both accumulated thousands of streams. The release of her music video for "Take This Slow" has received the attention of over 1,000 viewers. Additionally, Vinlisa has performed a wide spectrum of music venues from acoustic, intimate sessions at the Neutral Ground Coffeehouse and the Labyrinth to lively, upbeat shows at the House of Blues and Tipitinas.

She is currently a junior in college with plans to release her first EP. Her latest release, "Wake Me Up," is her introduction to her EP *Beyond*, which will be available on all streaming platforms on May 15, 2020. Her upcoming track "Sweet Tooth" will be her last single before the *Beyond*, which will be set to release on Sunday, March 15, 2020.
